1 I, Elaine Freitas, declare:

2 1. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth in this declaration and, if called as
3 a witness, I could and would testify competently to these facts under oath.

4 2. I was born on July 17, 1949 and am 62 years old. I live at 418 East Pomona
5 Avenue, Stockton, CA, 95207.

6 3. I was hired by the City of Stockton in November of 1996 and retired in November
7 of 2011 as a Library Aide II.

8 4. My spouse is my dependent on the City Health Plan. He was born on October
9 12, 1952 and is 59 years old. He is on Medicare disability and I will be eligible for Medicare
10 when I reach age 65.

11 5. My net monthly CALPERS retirement check is \$1,511.00. My household annual
12 income is 34,600.80 after taxes for 2012.

13 6. I am informed and believe that the City has adopted a monthly premium for
14 retiree health benefits. If I am required to pay the premium for the City's Health Plan for me and

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1 my spouse, even with the City's \$150 monthly subsidy, that would cost \$1,426.66 per month, or
2 \$17,119.92 annually. That represents 49% of my monthly pension.

3 7. Since my entire annual net income is \$34,600.80, paying these new health costs
4 would leave me only \$17,480.88 for my annual income. Dividing that into monthly installments
5 would leave me approximately \$1456.74 on which to live after paying for my health care benefit.

6 8. I am currently under a doctor's care and am required to have lab work done once
7 a month. I am also on medication. I am worried that obtaining other coverage would be denied
8 due to my pre-existing medical conditions.

9 I declare under penalty of perjury under the law of the United States of America that the
10 foregoing is true and correct and that this declaration was executed in Stockton, California on

11 June 23, 2012.
