1 I, Jeanette N. Schenck, declare:

2 1. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth in this declaration and, if called as
3 a witness, I could and would testify competently to these facts under oath.

4 2. I was born on August 28, 1952 and am 59 years old. I live at 9718 Fountain
5 Valley Drive, Stockton, CA 95209.

6 3. I was hired by the City of Stockton on February 4, 1986 and retired on August 29,
7 2007 as a Community Service Officer.

8 4. My spouse is my dependent on the City's Health Plan and is 60 years old. I have
9 enough quarters to qualify for Medicare when I reach 65. He would also qualify because he is
10 my spouse.

11 5. My CALPERS retirement check is \$1,741.08. My net annual income is \$49,000.

12 6. I am informed and believe the City has adopted a monthly premium for retiree
13 health benefits. If required to pay this premium to receive City Health Plan benefits, even with


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the \$300 subsidy, my premium would be \$1276.66 monthly, or \$15,319.92 annually. This represents 31% of my salary.

7. My husband has a chronic life-threatening illness which would likely limit our ability to obtain insurance from the marketplace due to his pre-existing condition.
