HAMMER LANE WIDENING PHASE 3B

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Hammer Lane will be widened from four lanes to six lanes between Alexandria Place and Thornton Road including the Pershing Avenue intersection within the unincorporated County. The work, in general, consists of constructing new pavement, repairing existing pavement, removing and placing curb, gutter, sidewalk, driveways and wheelchair ramps, relocating street lighting, traffic signal modifications, storm drain upgrades, constructing raised median, landscaping and irrigation, traffic striping, signing and pavement markings.
