SWAIN-MONTAUBAN ROUNDABOUT PROJ. NO.13-15 FEDERAL PROJECT NO. CML-5008 (129)

Project Description:

This project will convert a four way stop sign controlled intersection to a roundabout at the corner of Swain Road and Montauban Avenue. The project includes upgrading corner improvements to bring the intersection up to Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards for wheelchair accessibility, installation of fiber optic cable for a Pan-Tilt-Zoom (PTZ) camera, and installation of signs and striping. The upgrades will result in improved traffic safety, operations, and air quality, while also reducing delays. No right-of-way acquisition is required for this project.
