Qualifications

18 years of age or older.

A high school diploma or G.E.D.

Possess and maintain a current California Class "C" driver's license.

Legally authorized to work in the United States.

Vision requirements are 20/30 for visual acuity either corrected or uncorrected (if corrected, no more than 20/100 in each eye separately).

Color blindness is cause for rejection.

Hearing must be within Normal Range - 5/5

Able to pass written and physical ability testing.

Able to lift and carry equipment and patients weighing 165 pounds while wearing a self-contained breathing apparatus.

In accordance with Stockton Municipal Code Section 2.48.010(A), all sworn public safety officers and all regular emergency personnel in the employ of the City shall reside within a geographic area from which they can reach City Hall within 45 minutes.



Qualifications continued:

Prior to employment:

Successfully pass a comprehensive background investigation that includes a polygraph, psychological assessment, fingerprinting, medical exam, and drug screening.

Upon completion of one year of employment:

Must obtain a California Class B Restricted driver's license.

Must possess Certification as an Emergency Medical Technician- Basic within one year of employment.

Emergency Medical Technician - Basic training to be provided at Academy (if offered).
