The four Greyhound buses pick up passengers in Stockton each day with destinations to Sacramento, Los Angeles, Seattle and Portland, Oregon. Riders will now catch the bus at the specially marked stop on the east side of California Street near the corner of E. Weber Avenue, which is across the street from the DTC. As an additional option to public transit riders, they can ride RTD buses downtown to meet Greyhound buses for intercity travel.

**City of Stockton - Emergency Grant Program**

The Commercial Emergency Grant Program assists property owners in financial need with alleviating code violations where the health and safety of employees and/or public is endangered. The responsible party (property owner or business owner) must be able to demonstrate that alternate sources of funds (savings, loans, etc.) are not available to fix the problem. The City of Stockton Commercial Emergency Grant Program can provide up to \$7,500 in funds in the form of a grant with no repayment expected. Eligibility requirements:


- Commercial property must be within Stockton City limits;
- Must show proof of financial need, with no other available sources of funding; and
- Funds must be used to alleviate code violations.



## CITY OF STOCKTON CRIME PREVENTION CORNER

### Vehicle Theft - Basic Prevention Tips

Here are some helpful hints to avoid becoming a victim:

- Never leave your car running or the keys in the ignition when you're away from it, even for "just a minute."
- Never leave valuables in plain view, even if your car is locked. Put them in the trunk or at least out of sight.
- Always roll up the windows and lock the car at all times while driving or when it's in front of your home.
- Remove portable electronic devices such as smartphones and GPS navigation systems, including suction cup or bean bag type mounts. (Even the visible appearance of a suction cup ring on the glass windshield can be an enticement to a thief to break in and look for the GPS system.)
- Carry the registration and insurance card with you. Don't leave personal identification documents or credit cards in your vehicle.
- Park in busy, well-lighted areas.
- When you pay to park in a parking lot or garage, leave just the ignition key or valet key with the parking attendant. Make sure no personal information is attached. Do the same when you take your car for repairs.

### Auto Burglary

Auto burglary is a crime of opportunity by criminals who are "shopping" by looking in the windows of parked vehicles. To avoid being a victim, please:



- Do not leave valuables in plain view.
- Do not leave windows or sunroofs open.
- Do not leave doors unlocked.
- Do not leave keys in the vehicle.
- Do not leave the garage door opener in plain view.
- Do not leave out items with personal information.
- Do not move valuable items to the trunk while in public view.
- Slow down and use common sense before you leave your car.
