GENERAL PLAN UPDATE COMMUNITY MEETINGS TO "ENVISION STOCKTON"

(Stockton, CA) – The City of Stockton is updating its General Plan, the plan that determines future development and growth of the city, through the year 2040. Extensive community involvement and participation is essential to the process called "Envision Stockton." The new General Plan will serve as the City's blueprint for future decisions regarding land use, community services, mobility, housing, and resource conservation.

Two community workshops are currently scheduled. Everyone is welcome and encouraged to attend and participate. These meetings will cover the exact same information, which will introduce the project to the community and help define a long-term vision for Stockton.
